## Why is this survey so important?

This is your opportunity to tell local healthcare providers and policymakers about your health. **Your comments help improve healthcare and social services in this region.** You could get the call on your home phone or your cell phone.



- **Participating in the survey is free**, no one will try to sell you anything, and all of your responses are **completely confidential**.
- This will be the eleventh time the survey has been conducted in the region – by PHMC, a nonprofit public health institute. More than 10,000 households in Southeastern Pennsylvania will be interviewed from **June through August of 2008**.



- For the first time ever, the Household Health Survey is including an additional 3,000 households in Berks, Lancaster and Schuylkill Counties.
- This is a unique initiative – no other part of the country has an ongoing, consumer-based resource like this.
- The survey is supported by major charitable foundations, including The Pew Charitable Trusts, The William Penn Foundation, The United Way of Southeastern Pennsylvania, The Hospitals and Higher Education Facilities Authority of Philadelphia, and others.
