



More than four in ten (41.9%) Philadelphia adults changed their restaurant order based on new nutrition menu labels.

Of these, more than a third (38%) of adults switched their order to a lower calorie food when presented with nutritional information, Surprisingly, **1 in 25 (3.9%)** ordered a higher calorie food.




